This Course is open to Scouts BSA, Sea Scouts, and Venturers

Qualifications: Any Scout participating in this course must be at least a **First Class Scout and 13 years old (but not yet 18)**, and a Scout that **the Unit Leader** feels is mature and currently filling a unit leadership position or likely to assume a leadership position in the near future. The Scout may **only** attend on the Unit Leader's recommendation. It is important that the Scout have camping, cooking and hiking skills. **There is no rank requirement for Venturers but a recommendation is required.**

So that we can do advance planning, it is very important that all reservations are sent to the East Carolina Council office with full payment by April 15, 2020. **There are only 48 seats available for this class.** Anyone not fully paid by May 15, 2020 could be moved to the wait list.

What is NYLT? The National Youth Leadership Training Course is a one-week outdoor experience for youth leaders. This course supports the Unit Leader's responsibility for training the Unit's youth leaders. The course is conducted by a youth staff mentored by East Carolina Council's Training Committee using a syllabus published by the Boy Scouts of America. Scouting recognizes that Unit Leaders have the responsibility of training their own youth leaders. The purpose of the National Youth Leadership Training Course is not to assume the Unit Leader's role, but to support it. The Scout or Venturer will be exposed to skills they need to develop their leadership potential. The skills taught will immensely facilitate the Unit Leader's leadership development of the youth and directly benefit the Unit's program.

Course Details

11:00 am Monday June 15 to 4:00 pm Saturday June 20, 2020

Scouts are required to complete the course. It is important that all participants arrive on time in order to keep the program moving on schedule. A complete Boy Scout, Venture, or Sea Scout uniform (BSA pants/shirt and socks) is required for the course. A course cap is provided.

Participant Fee (on time) - \$215.00.

Late Registration Fee - \$225 (if not fully paid by May 15, 2020)
